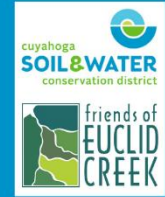
## Invasive Trade-Up Program

## To Be Eligible:

- Live or own property in the Euclid Creek Watershed
- Have one of our target invasive species on site
- Be willing to remove the invasive yourself
- Do NOT remove anything from your tree lawn

Registration will be open starting mid-March. Native plants will be available for pick-up in late-April or May. More information about target species on website.

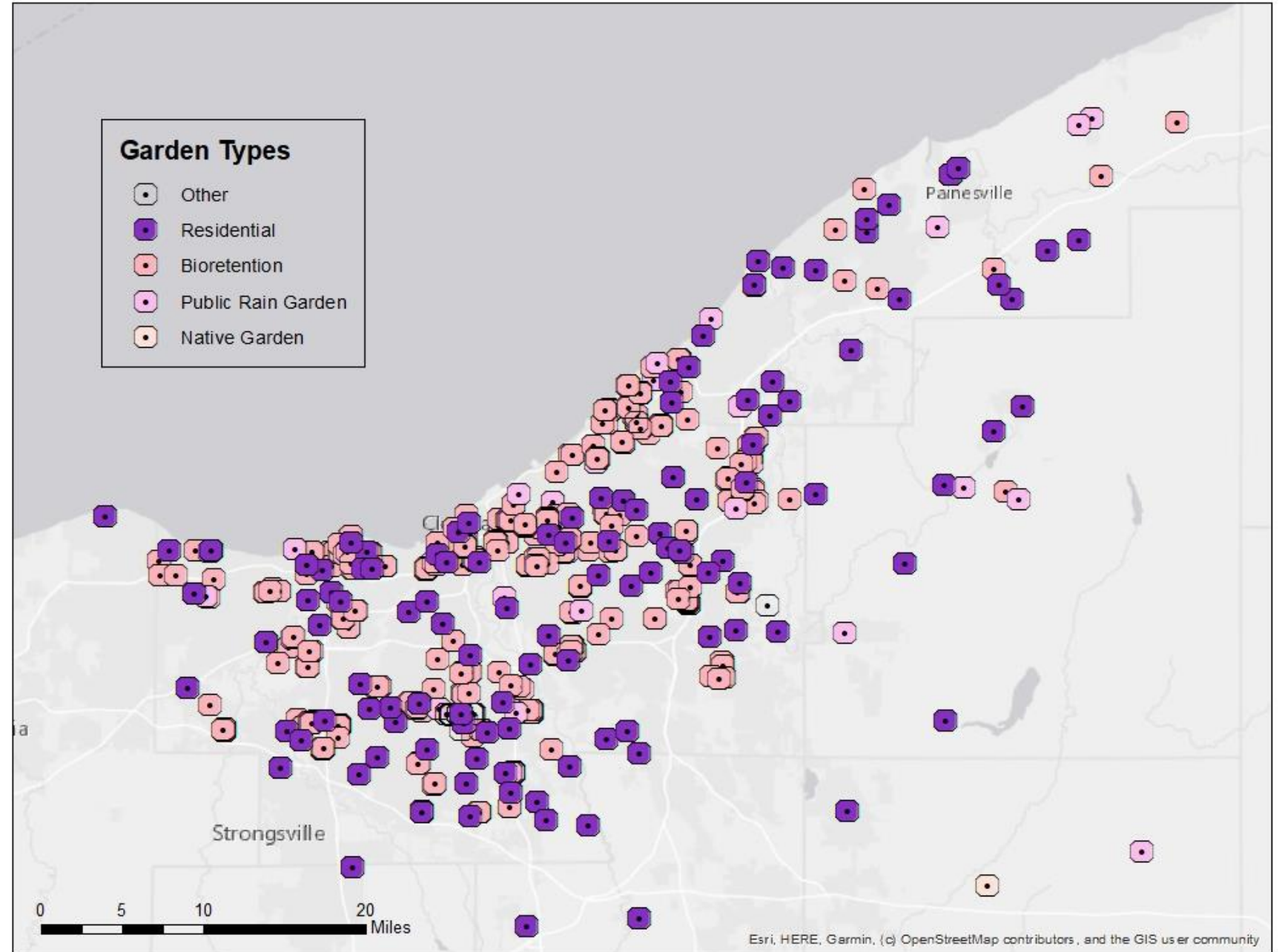

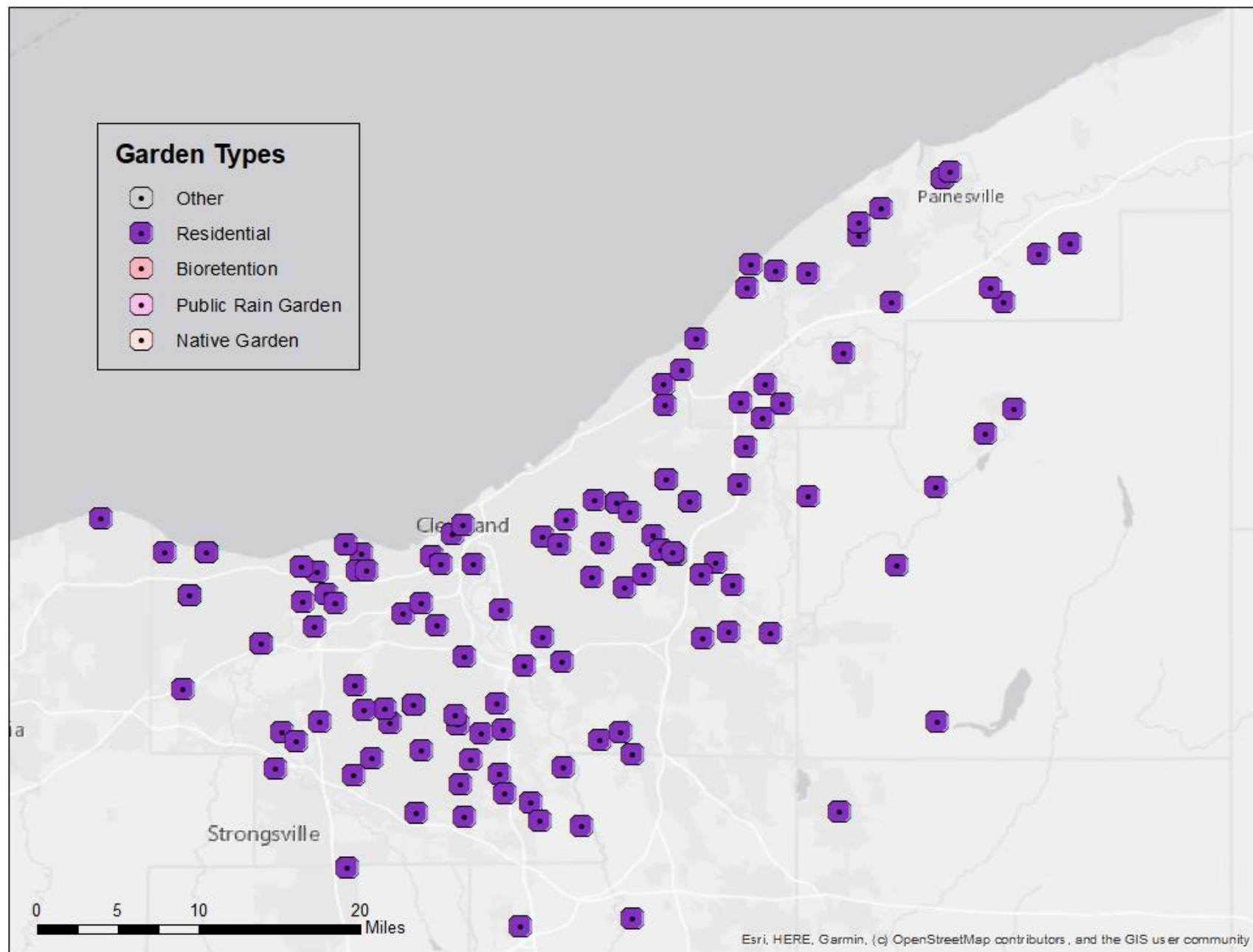

## Residential Gardens

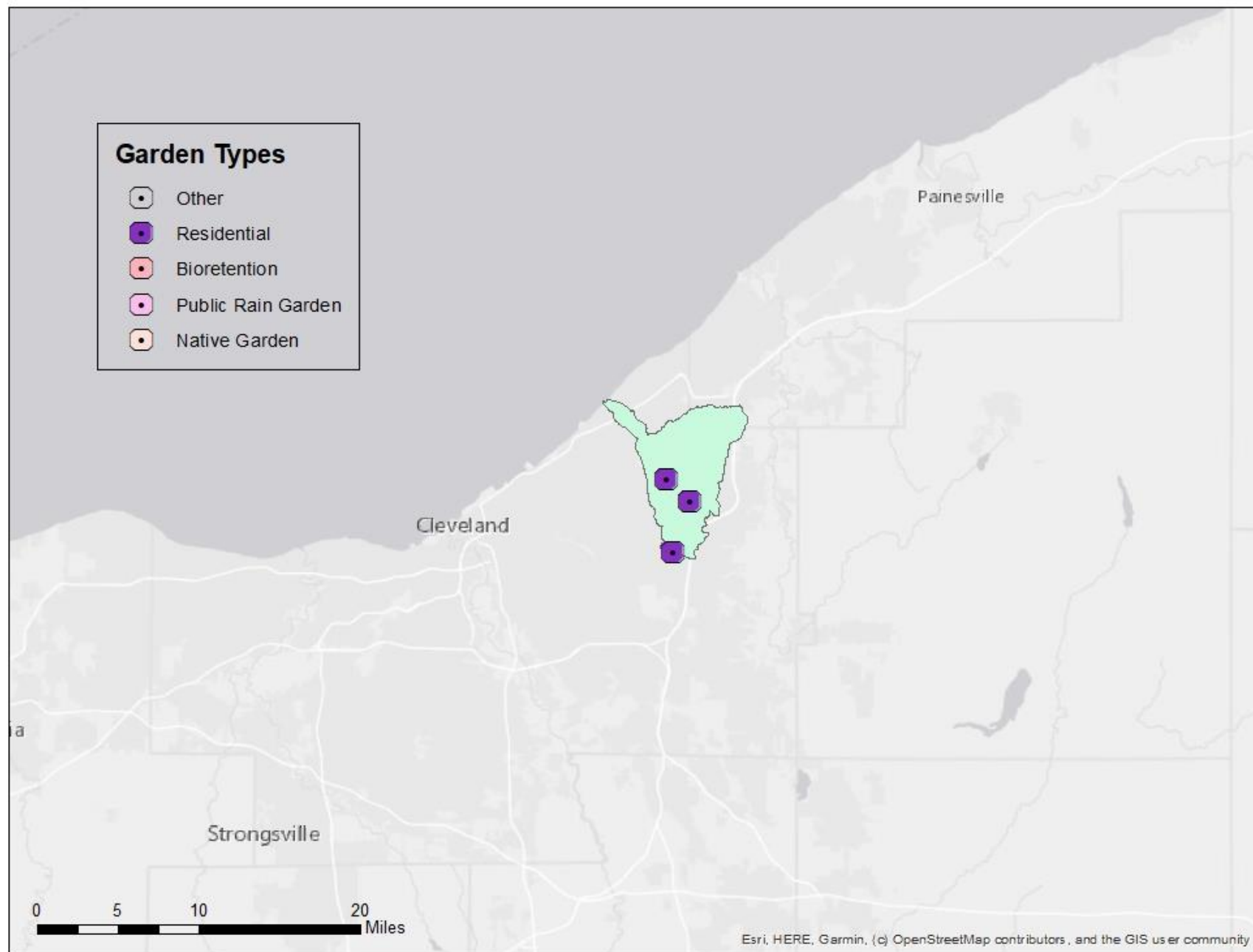

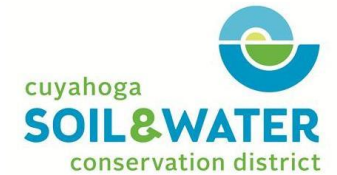

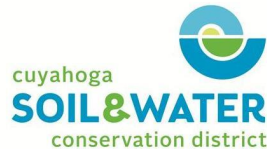
